Hunter-Wolff is one of the success stories, outgrowing its space in less than three years. Its new location - just a block away from the old - has twice the exhibition space and more natural light.

One reader of the Gazette and serious supporter of the fine arts, comments that "the gallery's expansion provides Colorado Springs with the opportunity to select from a larger body of work by some 35 artists, including collections by some of the region's top artists. The gallery does an excellent job of rotating exhibits and bringing in new collections on a regular basis." Collections include hand blown glass, fused glassware, wood turnings, fine furniture, gem-stone and silver jewelry, pottery, and framed or gallery wrapped paintings in oil, pastel, acrylic, watermedia, and mixed media in miniature to large scale.
